- Establishes priorities for land use and development; and
- Establishes legal standing for amending ordinances and other regulatory measures.

The Plan will describe what Bradford looks like today and what challenges need to be addressed for Bradford to continue to be a place to live, work, play and do business for many decades to come. 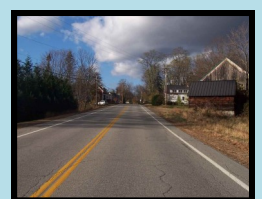

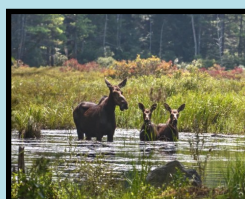

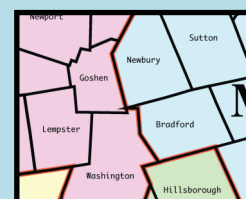
